MEMBERSHIP

1. Any person who is over the age of 18 years may become a Member of the Guild provided that the applicant accept and observe the Code of Conduct of the Guild.
All applicants for membership shall be in the form required by the Committee:
 - a) giving the qualifications of the proposed Member detail:
 - b) signed by the applicant and by their proposer and seconder who shall be Members of the Guild for not less than three (3) years standing:
 - c) must lodge or forward by post to the Secretary of the Guild at the registered office:
 - d) accompanied by the full amount prescribed entrance fee for the membership:
2. The Secretary shall cause such nominations to be posted on the noticeboard of the registered office of the Guild for a month prior to the Annual General Meeting and shall submit the names to the Annual General Meeting of the Guild for election. A person proposed for membership must receive a majority of the votes of all Members present and voting at the meeting before being accepted as a Member of the Guild. This voting shall be by secret ballot.
3. On election by the Guild the Secretary shall notify the applicant of his or her acceptance as a member of the Guild.
4. The Guild will inform applicant for membership in writing of;
 - a) the financial obligations arising from membership;
 - b) the circumstances, and manner, in which a Member may resign from the Guild
